Board of Director's Meeting - February 6, 2017

Meeting was called to order at 7p by president pro-tem Treasurer Alex Bozarth.

Discussion was held concerning DECA membership. Jordan Fox was charged with the development of a new and complete listing. It is estimated there is close to a hundred DECA members. Included in the discussion was the accounting of funds. There was no indication that there was a problem with the accounting. The discussion centered on how membership dues were collected. Ideas concerning collection of funds through PayPal were discussed.

Having a separate account for "Holiday for Heroes" was discussed. The consensus of the board seemed to be that a separate account was needed. The discussion was tabled.

The thought of bringing together "Crime Watch" and "Neighborhood Watch" was discussed. The dialog will continue with Chamblee Police.

Jordon Fox diligently attends meetings at PDK. There was nothing to report. However, a DECA resident has complained about the noise from jet traffic over his neighborhood. It is his contention that the noise could be a cause for lower property valuations and should be reflected in tax appraisals.

It was agreed DECA diners would continue the 3rd Friday of the month.

It was generally agreed (no vote taken) that DECA would be encouraged to help in clean-up activities in both Dresden Park and Dresden Elementary School.

Funds were approved for the use of the conference room at the American Legion Hall.

An announcement was made that there is an officer, a former Chamblee policeman, patrolling Dresden Park on a regular basis.

A formal planning session was requested to discuss future goal of the Board and the Organization as a whole.

Laurie Sedicino was approved by Board. Ms. Sedicino will represent Dresden Square.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:15p.
