### Discussion:

Decazette - Judy paid up for next issue (Jimmy). Need to follow up with Rick Hall for ad space (Paul)

Police/Citizen Ratios - Brief discussion concerning maintaining police/citizen ratios with the high density development occurring in parts of the city. No resolution or action item

Chris reported that the DECA calendar has been uploaded to NextDoor

Chris also reported that the 2019 DECA magnets with local contact info are ready for Neighborhood Rep pickup.

Jimmy Forwarded some articles to Paul for inclusion in upcoming Decazette issues.

Neighborhood Sign Toppers - Discussion concerning process with city on adding sign toppers at the entrances to DECA neighborhoods to reinforce local area identity. Tom Hogan explained the process that requires City Council to approve the design and labels used on the signs. Costs are paid by the organization bringing the request. Also, the budgeted cost is recommended by Tom Hogan to be \$100 per sign. **By unanimous vote, DECA Board approves moving forward with securing funds for the project.** **ACTION ITEM:** Neighborhood reps to determine number of sign toppers needed for their neighborhood.

Glass Recycling - No vote on this took place. There is desire to pursue the idea, but it might be too large to tackle at this time. The board feels that more research is required. **ACTION ITEM:** Jimmy will locate someone to spearhead the research.

Peachtree Greenway Letter of Support - No vote on this took place, but there was much discussion. There seems to have been confusion between the groups supporting the Greenway and the Mobility plan consultants. Tom Hogan stated that Chamblee was on board with the idea, and that it would be addressed in the mobility plan.
